

Planned Giving with Real Estate

Donating real estate—such as a home, farm, vacation property, or commercial building—can provide lasting support for Tanager while offering significant tax and financial benefits to you or your estate.

Blended Giving Tip

Consider combining a real estate gift now (e.g., outright, life estate, or bargain sale) with a future bequest to maximize impact and flexibility for your family.

Outright Gift

Transfer ownership of real estate directly to the charity during your lifetime.

<u>Benefits:</u> Immediate charitable income tax deduction, potential avoidance of capital gains, and removal from taxable estate.

Considerations: Ideally debt-free and readily marketable

Retained Life Estate (Life Estate Reserved)

Deed your home or farm to charity now but retain the right to live there for life.

<u>Benefits:</u> Immediate partial income tax deduction; you continue to use the property for life. <u>Considerations:</u> Donor is typically responsible for maintenance, insurance, and taxes until the life estate ends

Charitable Remainder Trust

Transfer property into a trust that sells/manages it and pays income to you or others for life or a term; remainder benefits the charity.

<u>Benefits:</u> Income stream, charitable deduction, and deferral/avoidance of capital gains on sale inside the trust.

Considerations: Requires trust administration, qualified appraisal, and sufficient asset value.



Real Estate, cont'd

Bequest

Leave real estate to the charity through your estate plan.

<u>Benefits:</u> Retain full control during life; may reduce estate taxes. <u>Considerations:</u> Transfer occurs after death; your estate manages any sale or liabilities.

Charitable Lead Trust (CLT)

Place property or proceeds into a trust that pays an income stream to charity for a set term, then transfers remaining assets to heirs.

<u>Benefits:</u> Prioritizes charitable support while potentially reducing gift/estate taxes for heirs. <u>Considerations:</u> More complex; best suited for larger estates and requires professional counsel.
