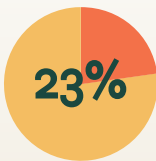

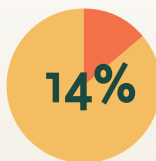

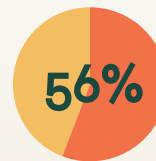

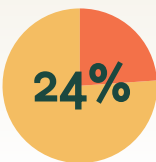

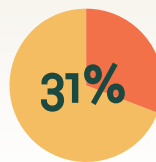

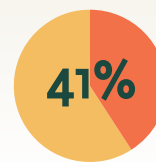
iMath Scores:

Programming Highlights

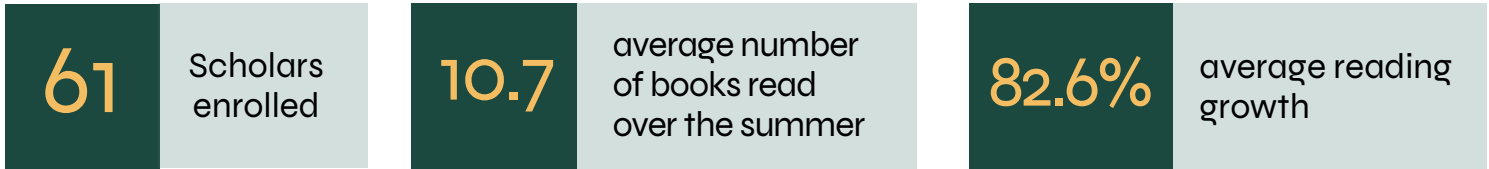



- Participated in **3** field trips.

2025 Summer Data & Outcomes



 Roosevelt Scholars reported above the nationwide average on 5 core competencies:

- Self-Awareness (84%)
- Self Management (85%)
- Social Awareness (91%)
- Relationship Skills (85%)
- Responsible Decision Making (83%)
